On screen:

Global citizens are a fast-growing population

In fact, 51% of the world's population now identify more as global citizens than as citizens of their home nation¹

High net worth individuals (HNWIs*) are more mobile than ever

With 26% planning to move countries this year alone²

*with wealth of at least 30 million

This mobility aligns with their desires for:

- Economic security
- Educational opportunities
- International careers

34% of the world's 211,000 ultra HNWI's hold a second passport

And a further 29% are planning to purchase one³

Wealthy global citizens own an average of 2.7 residential properties per household

And 23% are planning to buy an additional residential property outside their home country in the next year⁴

4,944 HNWI currently reside in London

making it the leading wealth centre in the world⁵

Followed by New York, Hong Kong, Singapore, Los Angeles
